- 8) How is Abraham father of the circumcised and all believers?
- 9) How is Abraham's faith described in verses 18-21?
- 10) Who else can be credited righteousness according to verses 22-25?
- 11) If we're only credited with righteousness by grace through faith, why do we often feel the need to work to earn God's favor?
- 12) How does this passage challenge or encourage you?
- 13) How can we pray for you this week?
