- 3) How do you suppose we can adopt this supernatural kind of reaction?
- 4) How do we reflect God's character when we "rejoice with those who rejoice" and "mourn with those who mourn"?
- 5) How did Jesus "mourn with those who mourn"? (See John 11.)
- 6) How is Christian mourning different from how the world grieves? (See 1 Thessalonians 4:13.)
- 7) Who does the one another point to in verse 16?
- 8) What does it mean to live at "harmony with one another"?
- 9) How does our pride keep us from living in harmony?
- 10) Who would qualify in Paul's day as "people in low position" and who would qualify today?
- 11) What is the end goal of associating with all people?
- 12) How does this passage encourage or challenge you to love differently?
- 13) How can we pray for you this week?
