- 7) What do the sailors understand about the nature and way to quiet the storm?
- 8) How does Jonah respond to the questions from the sailors?
- 9) Track the sailors' attitudes towards Jonah and the Lord through the course of the passage?
- 10) What is significant about where the fish came from?
- 11) How can we as Christians run away from God's purposes for us?
- 12) How does this passage inform us about God's pursuit of us?
- 13) How are you living out God's call on your life now?
- 14) How can we pray for you this week?
