- 8. How did Jonah's view of the lives of the people of Nineveh differ from God's view?
- 9. Describe the state of Jonah's heart at the end of this conversation with God?
- 10. How did Jonah, a prophet of God, so completely miss God's heart?
- 11. How could we miss God's heart for other people?
- 12. Read Matthew 5:43-45. How will you apply this passage and the book of Jonah in your life?
- 13. How can we pray for you this week?
