- 9) According to verse 25, does Paul seem to be indicating a foretelling of the future or a convicting forthtelling of truth?
- 10) Why is order important to Christian worship according to verses 33 and 40?
- 11) What does I Corinthians 14 indicate about a believer's control over their spiritual gifts?
- 12) How does this passage challenge or encourage you?
- 13) How will you obey God with your spiritual gifts this week?
