- 3) How is that important to His Divinity? To His Kingship? To being Messiah?
- 4) How is Jesus' eternal nature important to our eternal security?
- 5) Read Hebrews 13:8. How does this truth help you trust Jesus as Lord?
- 6) Jesus is not Father God, but He has some characteristics of a father, can you think of a few?
- 7) How does the thought of Jesus as our forever father comfort you?
- 8) Read John 10:22-30. Describe the connection between Father God and Jesus.
- 9) Why didn't the religious leaders believe in Him?
- 10) Why is it important that Jesus wasn't just "a mere man"?
- 11) In John 14:11, Jesus says that a good starting place to believing in Him is to believe His miraculous signs. How do these signs lead us to understanding who He is?
- 12) How does the title "Everlasting Father" challenge or encourage you in your relationship with Jesus?
- 13) How can we pray for you this week?
